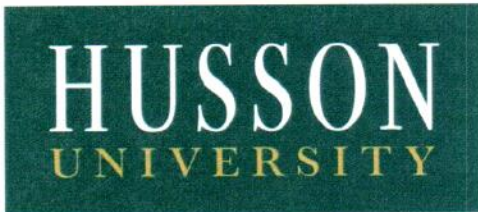

Candidates for a Bachelor of Science degree are required to complete a minimum of 124 semester hours maintaining a 2.5 overall cumulative grade point average and a C+ or better in their education courses. Transfer students must complete a minimum of thirty (30) credit hours at Husson University. At least fifteen (15) credits must be earned in Husson education courses prior to Student Teaching.
